Surgical Critical Care Intensive Unit (SICU)	Fellows will develop procedural skills and clinical understanding for management of trauma and critically ill surgical patients and will integrate from various places (ED, Recovery room, floor) to the SICU. Advancing fellows can also develop their clinical skills in a supervisory role with trauma and SICU residents.
Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU)	Fellows will gain knowledge of how to care for pediatric patients in pediatric ICU. This will cover trauma as well as any pediatric patient(s) requiring critical care. This includes the care of pediatric patients with traumatic brain or spinal cord injuries.
Cardiac Care Unit (CCU)	Fellows will obtain knowledge and skills to recognize, manage, and rescue patients with various cardiac and pulmonary pathologies, including post-operative open heart patients and those with pulmonary hypertension.
Trauma	Fellows will develop procedural skills and clinical understanding on managing trauma patients, integrating experiences from the ED to the Trauma ICU. Advancing fellows can further develop their clinical skills in a supervisory role with trauma residents.
